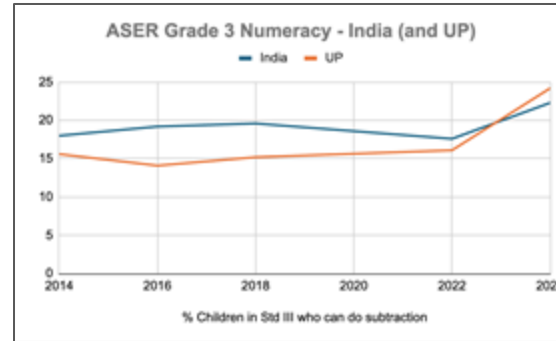
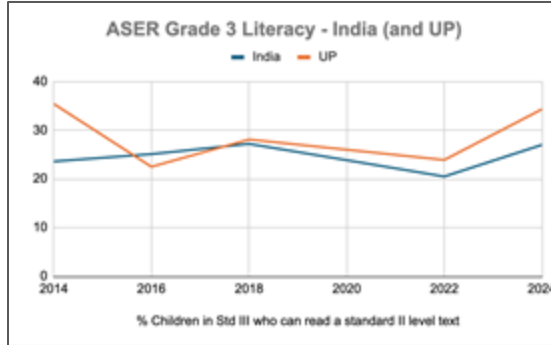

Goal Setting & Assessments

- Setting and aligning system-wide FLN goals and metrics
- Building salience with parents, political and community leadership



Structured Pedagogy

- Driving adoption of structured pedagogy
- Aligning teaching and learning resources with the FLN Outcomes



System Capacity Building

- Developing capacity of teachers for effective classroom practices
- Building middle management capacity in coaching, data management, and planning

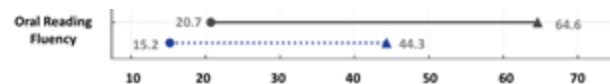


FLN Monitoring and Data

- Providing support on key governance issues
- Developing an assessments and monitoring system for data-based decision making

Last-mile implementation amplifies impact of first-mile structured pedagogy inputs,

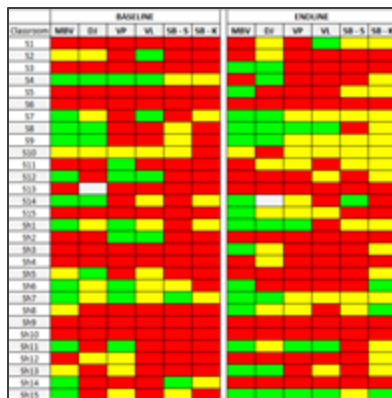


ORF Effect Size - 0.93* LLF in UP

.. by nudging the 4 teacher archetypes to move from low to high fidelity ..



High Fidelity : "I also do "You-do" and focus on whether students learn"

"Lesson Performer" : "I follow the lesson but mostly "I-Do"

"Activity Picker" : "I use the Teacher Guide but pick and choose some activities"

Non-User : "I haven't yet read a Lesson Plan in the Teacher Guide"
