## About this template

This template is for policy and practice submissions. You can use it to submit evidence or findings from a programme or policy to present at the What Works Hub for Global Education Conference (in place of submitting a research paper). This template must be submitted in addition to the online form that is designed to gather details about your programme or policy and the specific findings you will present.

Submissions will be evaluated based on their:

1. Relevance to implementation of foundational learning policies and programmes at scale.
2. Appropriateness of approaches and soundness of findings.
3. Applicability to other contexts.

Programmes/policies/studies that did not take place in the Global South will not be considered. If your organisation/programme would like to submit a policy or findings brief or an insight note that contains information similar to what is required in this template, you may do so instead of submitting this form. Policy Briefs and insight notes will be evaluated based on the same criteria as submissions via this template.
